*The objective of the conference is to discuss physical phenomena and processes in organic and inorganic materials and at their interfaces to other materials as well as prospects of their practical applications:*

## SCIENTIFIC PROGRAM:

1. Electronic processes at interfaces of organic materials to metals, as well as biological, organic, inorganic media;
2. Electro-optic processes in confined liquid crystals;
3. Thin film structures and their application;
4. Electronic processes within nanostructures and polymer composites;
5. Nonlinear properties of nanostructures, polymer composites, , NLO information recording;
6. Novel materials, structures and technologies;
7. Physics and technology of solar solar cells, LEDs, FETs, sensors.

Lectures (30-45 minutes), oral reports (15-20 minutes) and posters will be presented at the conference.

**PRIZE: Organizing Committee plans to establish the prizes for the best presentations of post-graduate students and young scientists. Details will be announced later.**

## SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION AND ABSTRACTS:

Applicants have to send to the Organizing Committee the application form written according to the rules indicated below, annotation text and abstracts of their reports. **Please, submit the application form and abstract to the secretaries of both the Organizing Committee and Program Committee by e-mail [icepom@iop.kiev.ua](mailto:icepom@iop.kiev.ua) and [lyubomyr@mail.ru](mailto:lyubomyr@mail.ru) until December 15, 2009 (deadline).**

Rules for the submission are given below.

The Program Committee will inform authors about the acceptance of their contributions before February 15, 2010.

It is planned to publish Abstract book in February 2010 and the Proceedings after the conference in two International journals. Information about reports submission is given below and will be specified on the ICEPOM-8 Web site: <http://www.iop.kiev.ua/~icepom8>

***Official language of the Conference is English.***

Conference fee is *US\$ 150* (including transportation from the airport and railway station to the conference site and back, coffee breaks, rent of conference hall and presentation equipment and copies of abstracts and proceedings).

Organizing Committee plans to decrease the conference fee for students and post-graduate students, if they indicated the necessity of discharge in Application form until **December 15, 2009.**

## APPLICATION SHOULD CONTAIN:

- ◆ full title of report ;
- ◆ names and affiliations of authors,
- ◆ number of the conference section;
- ◆ name of a lecturer, his/her title and affiliations ;
- ◆ postal address, phones, FAX, e-mail;
- ◆ type of the contribution (lecture, oral or poster report) and duration (for lecture and oral report).
- ◆ ask for the support (for students) \*

## RULES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS:

1. Abstracts in English should be prepared as a single A4 page (including figures, tables, references etc.)
2. Abstracts should be typed in Microsoft Word (Office 2000/2003 format) using single-spaced Times New Roman 12 pt font. All margins should be 1 inch.
3. The title is typed at the top of the page, using capital letters without hyphenation. Leave two blank lines before author's names, their addresses and affiliations. Leave two blank lines and then type the text of the Abstract.
4. Formulae and figures should be inserted in the text and if it is necessary are attached in separate files with of specification of used graphic program.
5. References should be given in the report body (for example [1]) and their list should be typed leaving two blank lines after the body of the abstract.
6. Abstracts and applications should be submitted by e-mail as attached files to the following addresses: [icepom@iop.kiev.ua](mailto:icepom@iop.kiev.ua) and [lyubomyr@mail.ru](mailto:lyubomyr@mail.ru).

## PROCEEDINGS SUBMISSION:


